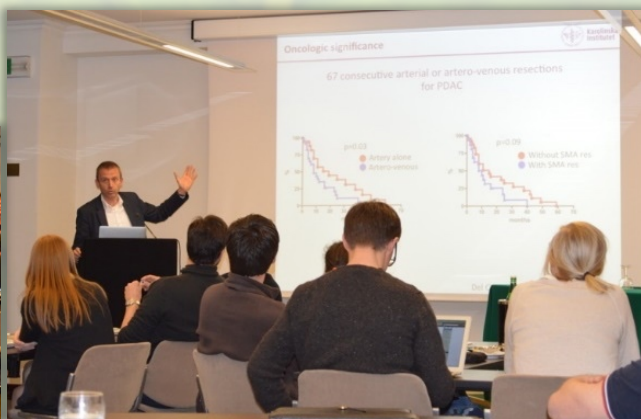
OBJECTIVES
